Overall Project Aim:

Ensure that high risk and vulnerable groups of men in the Buffalo City Municipality (BCM) make increasing use of appropriate multi-sectoral service and support measures leading to a reduction in the incidence of HIV among AGYW including GBV, positive changes in knowledge, attitudes and practices and increasing use of HIV, STI and TB comprehensive services and strengthen self-efficacy especially of the target HRG males.

- Manage and supervise the BI men programme teams activities
