Please confirm the HIVSS targets for Year 2 including PrEP clients and distribution as demand creation for PrEP?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This is a pilot for an initial one (1) year to be implemented during Year 2 for the funding cycle (NFM3).• The PrEP targets for the pilot thus correspond to Year 2 of the funding cycle.• We have provided a table with the targets for the entire funding cycle, including the ePharmacy contribution.• The ePharmacy project will deliver 40% of the total targets for the programme. Thus, the targets per district can be calculated as 40% of the total district targets.
2. Please confirm which HIVSS device will be used for the project?	OraQuick® HIVSS test kits
3. Please confirm that PrEP medication and HIVSS devices will be procured by Beyond Zero as the prime, the costs of which should not be included in our costing?	PrEP and HIVSS commodities will be provided by BZ and therefore not included in costing.
4. Please confirm if IEC materials will be provided by Beyond Zero and therefore costs for such not included in our costing?	IEC material linked to the project will be developed and disseminated by Beyond Zero.

Accreditation for the counsellor – 6.1 of the TOR talks to accreditation with SACSSP or HPCSA, however, the accreditation required in section 6.2 mentions HPCSA, SANC, SAPC, etc. Please confirm which accreditation will be accepted as counsellors are not accredited through SACSSP and lay counsellors are not accredited at all.	Counsellors will be engaged at Social Auxiliary worker level, hence the accreditation with SACSSP. These cadres are expected to have further training on basic HIV and AIDS.
