1.1	Are we allowed to finish the targets sooner than 30 March 2025?	Yes
1.2	Have you already procured the local SR's and training spaces? Do you have the exact location already?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SRs have been contracted already</li> <li>• Safe Spaces are also there, except for areas that are still securing additional safe spaces</li> </ul>
1.3	Venue costs? Will we use the local SR's safe space or are we responsible to procure and pay for the training space our self?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trainings will be conducted in the safe spaces, there will be no additional venue hire costs</li> </ul>
1.4	Just to clarify – Recruitment will be done by the local SR's, right?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Yes, the SRs will do the recruitment and send the enrolment forms to the Service Provider</li> </ul>
